- Performing daily checks on footballs and other relevant equipment for all squads

- Providing support and stock control measures for all kit deliveries and being a big part of the kit ordering process
- Using a heat press to print both training and match kits
- Managing the allocation of training and travel kit for all players and staff
- Carrying out all other kit and equipment related tasks deemed necessary by the club.
