Main role:

As the Head Physiotherapist the individual will be responsible for the physiotherapy provision of all first team players and management of all first team medical staff.

Responsibilities (but not limited to):

Daily

- Working as part of a multi-disciplinary team to optimise player physical development, health, and performance.
- Leading of medical pre-training player and staff management meetings.
- Assessment, diagnosis, treatment & intervention of all first team players reporting any symptoms or discomfort.
- Development of treatment plans of injured players to include progressive rehabilitation of injury, football and position specific fitness.
- Liaison with sports science and academy staff to ensure agreement & alignment of provision.
- Management of medical staff & external consultants to cater for the needs of both fit and injured players.
- Communication to management staff regarding player availability in training.
- Contributing to the effective implementation of injury prevention strategies.
- Reporting of player availability and injury updates to key stakeholders.
- Planning of provision for all players and staff.
- Liaison with Club Doctor to manage consultations of injured players.
- Recording of SOAP notes of all injured players.

Weekly

- Review and evaluation of practices, procedures and protocols.
- Reporting of player availability, injury updates and all relevant player information to key stakeholders.
- Planning & organisation of provision for the following weeks training schedule.
