The more people who join, the bigger and better the FTOSC will be and this will enable us to represent your views and wishes.

Two editions of "Codsmag" per season (we are working on a new fans magazine) to be sent to members by email or post.

VIP invites for Juniors (and adults) to a Christmas Party and other similar activities.

The lifeblood of any Football Club or Supporters Organisation are the Juniors. We are planning various Junior events this season that will be particularly aimed at our younger supporters. We have several other events planned and our aim is to establish the FTOSC as an absolute "must" to join.
